MINUTES

A. CALL TO ORDER

Hearing Officer Ablao called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

B. CONSENT CALENDAR

1. **RENEWAL LICENSE REISSUE - Tavern License (City)**

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the public hearing for a Reissue License for The Mill Event Venue.

Brandon Ribble, owner, was sworn in by Officer Ablao.

Mr. Ribble presented to the Liquor Licensing Authority regarding the reason for a late renewal filing which led to a reissue license application.

Town Prosecutor, Amy Penfold, stated that the Town has no concerns. Commander Zeigler, with the Windsor Police Department, also did not have any concerns.

Officer Ablao stated the concern of alcohol being sold, served and consumed during the period of the liquor license being expired, and a renewal or reissue application not filed with the Local Licensing Authority.

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the meeting for public comment, to which there was none.

Officer Ablao removed herself from the Board Chambers at 9:10 a.m. in order for Mr. Ribble and Prosecutor Penfold to discuss how he would like to proceed regarding the violations. Officer Ablao returned to the Board Chambers at 9:14 a.m.

Prosecutor Penfold stated that the Town and Mr. Ribble are in agreement to a ten-day suspension held in abeyance based upon no further violations over the next twelve months. Officer Ablao stated that Mr. Ribble has the right to a Show Cause Hearing unless admitting to the violations. Mr. Ribble stated that he admits to the violations.

The Authority finds that the evidence presented, and the documents submitted with the application support the approval of this Reissue License and therefore approves the granting of the liquor license renewal. There is a ten-day suspension held in abeyance based upon no further violations over the next twelve months.
