1. Sculpture on Loan “SoL of Windsor” Locations – Chris Bates recapped the walk around Windsor Lake. The questions posed were, how close together should the sculptures be placed? It was decided that we are going to go with 5 sculptures, they will be located on the S/SW portions of the lake. The plinths will be placed within viewshed of each other from the put-in at the lake to the first bridge on the NW corner.
