**C. ACTION ITEMS**

1. **NEW - Hotel & Restaurant License (City)**

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the public hearing for a New Hotel and Restaurant License for Street of India Curry & Grill.

Ram Basnet, owner, and Patrick Maroney, with Alcohol Petitioning Services, were sworn in by Officer Ablao.

Mr. Basnet, presented to the Liquor Licensing Authority regarding the Hotel and Restaurant License.

Town Prosecutor, Amy Penfold, requested clarification on the violation policy, which the owner answered.

Patrick Maroney, presented to the Liquor Licensing Authority regarding the Neighborhood Needs and Desires Petitioning results.

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the meeting for public comment, to which there was none.

Inspection of the Premises was conducted by Officer Burrell on June 11, 2025, and passed, with no concerns from Windsor Police Department.

The Authority finds that the evidence presented, and the documents submitted with the application support the approval of this Hotel and Restaurant License and therefore approves the granting of the license upon satisfactory results of any background checks, compliance with the liquor code, rules, regulations and municipal ordinances.

2. **NEW - Tavern License (City)**

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the public hearing for a New Tavern License for Twin Staves.

Ryan Spilborghs, owner, and Patrick Maroney, with Alcohol Petitioning Services, were sworn in by Officer Ablao.

Mr. Spilborghs, presented to the Liquor Licensing Authority regarding the Tavern license.

Town Prosecutor, Amy Penfold, requested information regarding the Human Resources firm to be utilized, which the owner answered.

Patrick Maroney, presented to the Liquor Licensing Authority regarding the Neighborhood Needs and Desires Petitioning results.

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the meeting for public comment, to which there was none.

The Authority finds that the evidence presented, and documents submitted with the application support the approval of this Tavern License and therefore conditionally approves the granting of the license with the following conditions:

- TIPS Certificate submitted to the Authority by Mr. Spilborghs after course completion
- Certificate of Occupancy issued by the Planning Department
- Satisfactory inspection of the premises by the Windsor Police Department
- Compliance with the liquor code, rules, regulations and municipal ordinances

Pursuant to state law, the license will not actually be issued until such time as the building has been inspected by the Windsor Police Department to determine compliance with the diagram submitted with the application.
