Windsor Police Department had no concerns.

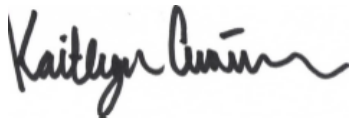
Hearing Officer Ablao opened the meeting for public comment, to which there was none.
